INFORMATION FOR THE JUDGMENT DEBTOR
(the party against whom a money judgment has been entered)

You may appeal this judgment if rendered by a Judge after trial. The Small Claims booklet outlines the procedure. You may call the Small Claims Clerk if you have any questions. Your failure to pay the judgment may subject you to any one of a combination of the following:

- a) garnishment of wage;
- b) garnishment of bank account(s);
- c) a lien on real and/or personal property;
- d) seizure and sale of real property;
- e) seizure and sale of personal property, including automobiles;
- f) suspension of motor vehicle license and registration; if claim is based on judgment debtor's ownership or operation of a motor vehicle;
- g) revocation, suspension, or denial of renewal of any applicable business license or permit;
- h) investigation and prosecution by the State Attorney General for fraudulent or illegal business practices; and
- i) a penalty equal to three times the amount of the unsatisfied judgment plus attorney's fees, if there are other unpaid claims

THE JUDGMENT IS VALID FOR A PERIOD OF 20 YEARS, IF THE JUDGMENT IS NOT COLLECTED UPON THE FIRST ATTEMPT, FURTHER ATTEMPTS TO COLLECT MAY BE MADE AT A LATER DATE.
