## § 1800.9. Issuance of license--Term--Renewal and disciplinary proceedings--Expiration dates

- **A.** Upon receiving proper application, payment of the proper license fee, and certification of recommendation by the Alarm and Locksmith Industry Committee, the Commissioner of Labor shall issue a license to the applicant. The license shall be valid for a one-year term.
- B. Renewal of a license shall not prohibit disciplinary proceedings for an act committed prior to the renewal.
- **C.** The Commissioner may adopt a system under which licenses expire on various dates throughout the year. For any change in such expiration dates, license fees shall be prorated on an appropriate periodic basis.
